

Peterborough Action for Tiny Homes: PATH P.O. Box 61, Peterborough ON K9J 6Y5

Dear PATH supporter,

You are a valued community member; someone who cares about the city of Peterborough and all its residents. The homelessness crisis has hit us hard. There are at least 300 people unhoused. PATH has been working on solutions and has purchased 10 sleeping cabins, with 5 more ready to be built; we are working with the city to get all the necessary permissions.

PATH has been successful in helping to move the homelessness crisis to the top of the city's agenda. City council has adopted the "transitional supportive model of modular units" (sleeping cabins) with wraparound services which PATH has been promoting for several years. This development is welcome but not enough. There will be people left unhoused. Some would prefer to be out of downtown. The PATH website <u>www.pathptbo.org</u> has information on Phase 1 and Phase 2, plus other important information.

PATH has secured a three-year lease with Habitat for Humanity for the sleeping cabins pilot project at 385 Lansdowne St. E. We have a financial partner in the Brock Mission, enabling donors to get tax receipts. The Elizabeth Fry Society of Peterborough is our operational partner providing the necessary wraparound services. While we await city council approvals to put residents in our sleeping cabins, we are starting with a modified day program, "**Ready for Home**".

With no government funding, we have relied on generous donors and volunteers. Despite all our steps forward, we needed, when we formed this fundraising committee in August, to raise \$240,000 by December. **We have already raised 80% of our target for this year!** We need you to get us all the way there. A new fundraising target will be set for 2024-2025. We have been told we need to show to the city "financial stability", as a non-governmental grassroots group.

Please consider donating to PATH this Christmas. Your gift will change the future for people experiencing homelessness.
