

# **Reconciliation & First Communion Registration**

September 9, 2024

#### Dear Parents:

I am writing to you as pastor of Assumption Parish to share good news for your child and family. With the support and engagement of you as parents, the parish and Catholic school community, I look forward to assisting your child to prepare to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist.

Your child is in Grade 2 or 3 and is a potential candidate for the reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.

His Excellency Bishop Miehm, Bishop of Peterborough continues to bring the parishes of the Diocese together to offer a Sacramental Preparation Program that is consistent in form and content. This initiative is designed to assist the home, school and parish in nurturing the faith of your child as you prepare them for receiving the sacraments. Again this year we will be using the program - Signs of Grace.

All of the Catholic parishes in the Diocese work closely with the school communities. The Catholic schools provide Religious and Family Life Education for your child and the parishes provide the Sacramental Preparation Program for your child. The Sacramental Preparation Program will be offered at the parishes.

There will be a Information and Registration Night to further explain the Sacramental Preparation Program and how you can continue to support your child's faith development. The Parent Information Night will be held on September 23, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. in the Church at Assumption Parish.

There will be 7 sessions for First Reconciliation and 9 sessions for First Eucharist and the sessions will run about seventy-five minutes in length. Catechists from the parish community will facilitate the Sacramental Preparation Program with your child. The Sacramental Preparation Program is required for your child to understand the significance of the sacraments and to receive these sacraments this year.

Dates for these sessions will be given out at registration

There is a fee of \$25 for each Sacramental Preparation Program totaling \$50 over the year to help offset the cost of the materials. Your child will receive two books, Signs of Grace - You Are Forgiven and Signs of Grace - You Are Loved. Kindly bring the fee and a copy of your child's baptismal certificate to the registration Night.

As Pastor, I am responsible in collaborating with the Bishop in following Canon Law and Diocesan Policies to ensure that all the requirements are completed in preparation for the celebration of these sacraments for your child. If your child has not been baptized yet, please feel welcome to contact me at your earliest convenience.

The parish community is looking forward to supporting your child in prayer as they prepare to receive the sacraments and celebrating this time of God's grace with your child and your family.

I take this opportunity to assure you of my prayers and a very warm welcome at Our Lady of Assumption Parish.

#### **Dear Parents:**

As pastor of Our Lady of Assumption Parish and with the support and engagement of you as parents, your child's sponsor, and Catholic school community, our parish looks forward to assisting your child to prepare to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Your child in Grade 7 or 8 is a potential candidate for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation next year.

His Excellency Bishop Miehm, Bishop of Peterborough is continuing to encouraged the parishes of the Peterborough Diocese to offer a parish-based Sacramental Preparation Program that is consistent in how young people prepare and in what they receive as faith formation. This initiative is designed to assist the home, school and parish in nurturing the faith of your child as they prepare to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

All of the Catholic parishes in the Diocese work closely with the school communities. The Catholic schools provide Religious and Family Life Education for your child and the parishes provide the Sacramental Preparation Program for your child. The Sacramental Preparation Program will be offered at the parishes and supported by the schools.

There will be a Confirmation Information Night and Registration for Parents, and Candidates on September 26, 2024 in Assumption Church to further explain the Sacramental Preparation Program and more details about the sacramental preparation program for Confirmation will be presented then. Plan for about 90 minutes.

<u>Please Note</u>: Your child should be registered in the Parish where you regularly attend Mass.

There is a fee of \$50 for the Sacramental Preparation Program to help offset some of the cost of the materials. If this expense poses a concern, I strongly encourage you to speak with me so that our assistance can be offered to you. Please bring payment and a copy of your child's baptismal certificate to registration.

As Pastor, I am responsible in collaborating with the Bishop to pastorally implement the Code Canon Law and Diocesan Policies and to ensure that all the requirements are completed in preparation for the celebration of this sacrament for your child. If your child has not been baptized or received the sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist, I encourage you to contact me at your earliest convenience.
